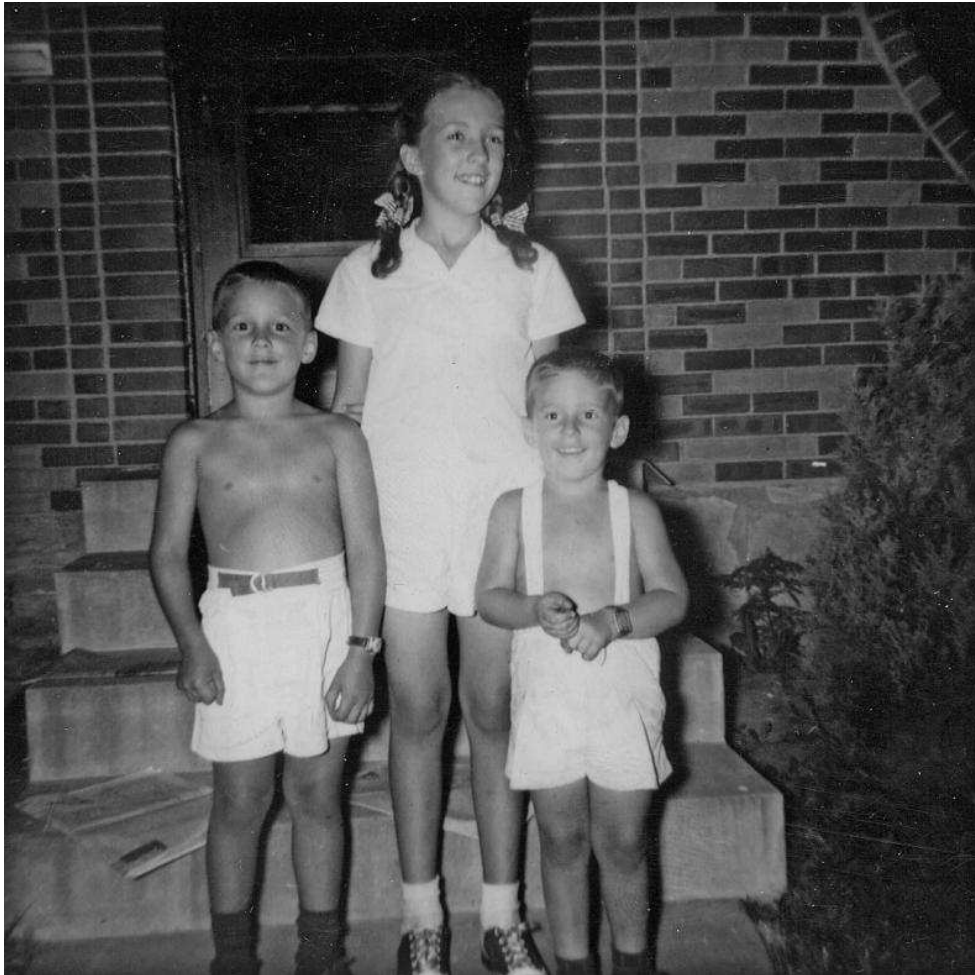
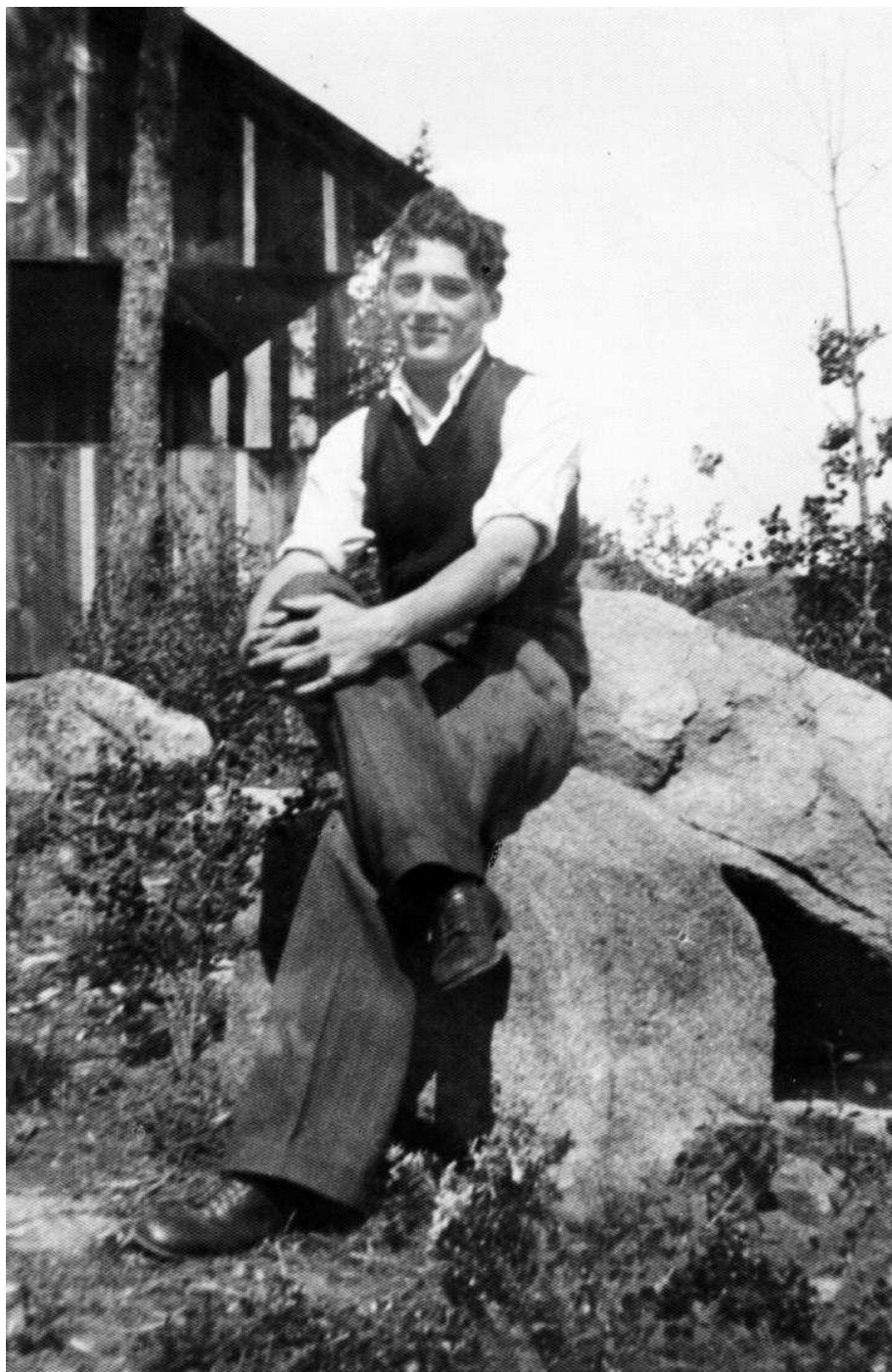

Judith, John and Bill Stenzel in front of their Kansas City home in 1949.



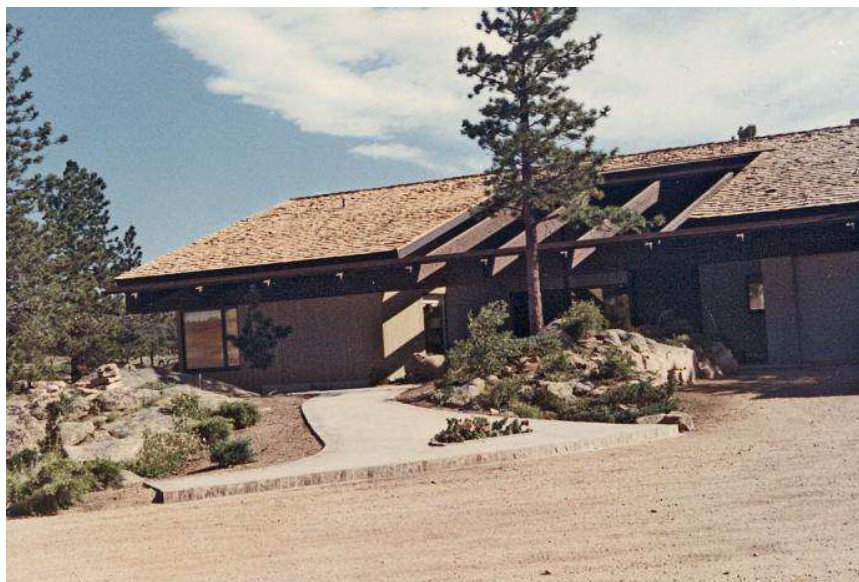
A young Ray Stenzel in front of the Galloup family cabin
