

# FOX ACRES UPPER CABIN “SUNNING ROCK”



The cabin was constructed in 1926 and was originally known as the “Upper Cabin”, marking the inception of Fox Acres. In addition to the “Upper Cabin”, the Fox House was built and was used to observe fox mating. The Fox Farm ceased operations in 1950. In Aug 1960, the property was acquired by Ray Stenzel, who made the Fox House his first residence and converted the “Upper Cabin” for guest use, and thereafter referred to the cabin as “Sunning Rock”. Over the past century, the cabin has undergone several renovations and remains a cherished second home located in Fox Acres.
