In the year 1946 the military personnel from the Livermore area came home, looking forward to family, friends and their livestock. But there is something missing, their music hall is gone. Where will they meet, eat, dance and enjoy being home? George and Ernest Roberts saw the need and donated property to the community for a new Community Hall. After two years of fundraising by local clubs and neighbors, the building was ready to open. Grand opening was November 20, 1948. On Saturday night there would be a square dance or a country music dance. Even today there are still community meetings, weddings, memorial services, concerts and dances. All of this has happened thanks to members of the community that donate their time to care for this historic building and provide what the Livermore community needs.
