

SILVER FOX FARM **NOW FOX HOUSE AT FOX ACRES**



A Silver Fox farm was considered a good business enterprise to include in the planning for Red Feather Lakes. This actually begun early in the development, although not on the site indicated in the original layout. The Fox Farm incorporation was dated November, 1925. The plan was called "Circle Ranch" and the capacity was for one hundred fox pairs to be raised for their pelts. A manager from New York was hired. The Fox House above was for the manager where he could view the fox pens from the cupola and tourist were encouraged to come to view the foxes. In the 1950's the market for fox pelts declined and the property was sold to Ray and Mary Galloup Stenzel.



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
